

Dr. Welshons is Associate Professor of Biomedical Sciences in the College of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Missouri-Columbia. He obtained his B.A. from Yale University in Biology, Ph.D. from Harvard University in Anatomy, and postdoctoral training at the University of Wisconsin-Madison in Biochemistry and Human Oncology with Jack Gorski and V. Craig Jordan. His research is on estrogen action in human breast cancer cells, and has focussed on mechanisms of environmental estrogen action of bisphenol A including pharmacokinetics, and current human exposures to xenoestrogens.
